Rationale:	This scheme builds on ensemble skills from year 7 and deepens understanding of musical elements.	This scheme builds on keyboard work from year 7 and introduces pupils to new techniques.	This scheme introduces students to a programme for producing music and builds on their knowledge from unit 2 where they played and listen to ground bass compositions.	This scheme builds on previous ensemble work and allows pupils to collaborate as popular musicians and work on their ability to play in time.	This scheme builds on music production skills, composition skills and keyboard skills enabling pupils to develop a longer composition to go with a media clip.
