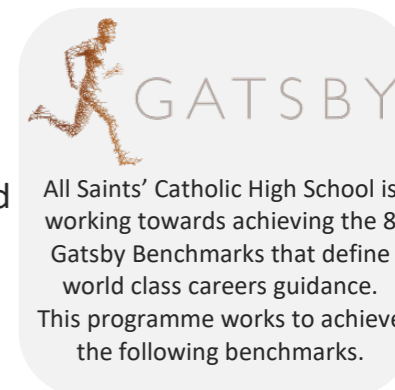




# All Saints' Careers Programme
