Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this message finds you and your families safe and well.

I am writing to remind you that school reopens on **Tuesday 2nd December**, which also marks the beginning of the **Year 11 Mock Examinations**. All students must arrive in **full school uniform** and be in school for **8.30am**.

As we continue to settle into our wonderful new school building, it is essential that we work together to protect this fantastic environment and ensure students are fully prepared to maximise their learning time.

I would like to remind all parents and carers of our expectations regarding **uniform and equipment**.

Uniform and Conduct Inside the School Building

- All students must bring the **correct uniform and equipment** in a school bag every day.
- On entry to the building, students will be expected to **remove coats and scarves**.
- Coats and scarves **must not be worn inside the building** and may only be put back on once students leave at social time or at the end of the school day. These must be **carried with them** during the day.

Uniform Policy Reminders

Please can I draw your attention to the following points from our uniform policy:

- **Hoodies are not permitted** at any time.
Any hoodies worn by students will be **confiscated** and can be collected at the end of the school day.
- **White socks are not allowed**.
If a student wishes to wear socks as well as tights for additional warmth, these must be worn **underneath** their tights and not visible.
- **Excessive make up is not permitted**. Students who choose to wear excessive make up will be asked to remove it, this includes fake/spray tan and false eyelashes.
- **Eyebrow piercing, nose studs, tongue piercing and other piercings are not allowed**; students will be asked to remove these. If they refuse, they will be placed in the Emmaus Centre until they do so.

Your support in ensuring your child arrives at school each day dressed appropriately and ready to learn is greatly appreciated. Maintaining high standards helps us foster a respectful, orderly and aspirational environment for every young person in our care.
