Following my recent letter outlining our uniform and equipment expectations for September, I wanted to send a further reminder to ensure that families have plenty of time to prepare before the summer holidays.

Our aim is to provide as much notice as possible so that parents and carers can spread the cost of purchasing any new items and avoid unnecessary last-minute expense.

Uniform Expectations

From September 2026, the only **compulsory branded** uniform items will be:

- All Saints' School jumper
- All Saints' School tie
- All Saints' School skirt
- All Saints' PE top

All other uniform items may be purchased from a retailer of your choice, provided they meet the school's published uniform expectations.

As previously communicated, **all students will also be expected to wear plain black school shoes**. This forms part of our ongoing commitment to maintaining consistently high standards and ensuring a smart, professional appearance for all students.

Equipment Expectations

Every student should attend school each day with:

- A school bag
- A black or blue pen
- A pencil
- A ruler

Being fully equipped enables students to begin learning immediately and helps maximise valuable lesson time.

Jewellery and Appearance

Please also remember that students may wear:

- Two small stud earrings in each ear
- Short, natural nails

The following are not permitted:

- Hoop earrings
- Facial or body piercings
- False eyelashes
- Acrylic, gel or false nails

Over the coming weeks we will continue to remind families of these expectations so that every student is fully prepared for a successful start to the new academic year.
