Mission Statement

Uniform is an important part of school life. We expect pupils to wear their full uniform as intended at all times. It ensures that pupils look smart, are look the same but remain unique in themselves. If worn properly it shows they are proud of themselves and are proud of the school

Students are ambassadors of the school and are expected to dress and behave in a way that reflects the standards we seek to achieve.

The uniform should be smart with all items clearly marked with your child's name.

Pupils who do not conform to the school's uniform and appearance policy will be sanctioned in line with our Behaviour Policy.

Boys Years 7 - 11:

- BLAZER navy blue blazer with School badge
- SHIRT white (short or long sleeved), that should be tucked in at all times.
- SHOES plain, black, sturdy shoes without logos (Please note that black training shoes, pumps, fabric shoes or boots are NOT acceptable).
- JUMPER blue, encrested V-necked jumper.
- TIE All Saints' Catholic School tie (navy and gold).
- SOCKS plain black
- TROUSERS black school trousers
- COATS should be appropriate school wear and not fashion (navy or black)
- BAG should be black or navy.

Girls Years 7 - 11:

- BLAZER navy blue blazer with School badge
- SHIRT white (short or long sleeved), that should be tucked in at all times.
- TIE All Saints' Catholic School tie (navy and gold).
- SHOES plain, black shoes without logos (Please note that black training shoes, pumps, fabric shoes or boots are NOT acceptable). JUMPER – blue, encrested Vnecked jumper.
- TROUSERS OR SKIRT
 - TROUSERS— black loose-fitting trousers (not leggings)
 - SKIRT All Saints' Catholic School tartan skirt only (knee length)
- TIGHTS plain, thick, black tights. No patterns
- OR SOCKS black
- COATS should be appropriate school wear and not fashion garments (navy or black)
- BAG should be black or navy.

PE Uniform - Boys Years 7-11:

- All Saints' royal blue multisport shirt
- Roval blue badged shorts
- Royal blue match socks
- Royal blue alpha hoody (optional)
- Royal blue alpha rain jacket (optional)
- Navy blue badged alpha sweatpants (optional)
- Football boots, shin pads and gumshield
- Trainers

PE UNIFORM GIRLS Y7-11

- All Saints' royal blue multisport shirt
- Royal blue badged shorts
- Royal blue match socks
- Royal blue alpha hoody (optional)
- Royal blue alpha rain jacket (optional)
- Navy blue badged alpha sweatpants (optional)
- Plain hair bobble (hair must be tied up for all PE lessons)
- Trainers, shin pads.

Regardless of injury or illness, pupils are expected to bring a full School PE kit to all lessons in order to participate in a variety of roles.

JEWELLERY

The only jewellery permitted in school is one stud per ear, in the lower lobe. In any physical activity the studs must be removed. Ear piercing should be done at the start of the summer holiday so that a stud may be worn in September. Eyebrow piercing, nose studs, tongue piercing and other piercings are not allowed. Digital and analogue watches can be worn but not Smart watches.

No other items of jewellery are permitted. This is because of the potential risk of accidental damage from the wearing of such items and as such they may be confiscated. We will do our best to assist your child in safeguarding their property, however, the school does not take any responsibility for the loss of or damage to personal possessions brought on to site.

HAIR AND MAKEUP

Pupils are expected to wear hair in a neat and acceptable style. Hair must be of one natural colour. For example; blue, green, pink and red are not natural colours. Hair styles (including shaved heads) judged to be extreme by the Headteacher are not permitted. Hair fashion accessories are also not to be worn. If hair bands are worn they should be navy blue or black only

Make-up, including coloured nail varnish, lip gloss and fake tan, is not to be worn. False nails or other such beauty accessories are not acceptable.

SUMMER UNIFORM

In times of extreme weather the Headteacher may make to decision to relax uniform requirements i.e. jumper and/or tie may no-longer need to be worn. This will be communicated via the normal communication channels.
